## ABOUT THE NEMSR

The National Environmental Monitoring Sites Register (NEMSR) provides a consolidated view of Australia's high-quality environmental monitoring sites.

For the first time, users can access consistent information for sites across environmental domains.

The NEMSR displays key attributes such as data custodian, location, observation types and methods. Where available, it also links to the observational data itself.

Networks already available include seismic monitoring stations, ocean radars, long-term weather stations, and ground cover reference sites.
